## Kroger's Neighbor to Neighbor Program



Present this flyer with your organization's barcode to your cashier upon checkout. After they have scanned your KrogerPlus Card you will be enrolled for the current year of the Kroger Neighbor to Neighbor Donation Program. Every time you shop at Kroger and use your enrolled KrogerPlus Card, Kroger will contribute a percentage of you eligible purchase to LHS PTSA. Once a card is linked to an organization barcode, it will be active for the remainder of the program year.

## Albertson's Community Partner Program

Albertson's unveiled a new community partner program last year, when they quit using the "Preferred" card. Here are temporary key cards for you to use when you shop at Albertson's. Cut out this temporary scan card then simply scan them at the beginning or end of your check out and 1% of your purchase will be donated to LHS PTSA by Albertson's. New cards will arrive by the 1st week of December, check the school office for the cards.



## Ink Cartridge Recycle

You can also help by sending any empty ink and toner cartridges to the LHS offices. The PTSA will sort and recycle the cartridges with Staples. For every Dell, Lexmark, HP and Kodak the PTSA receives a **\$3.00** ,per cartridge, reward to be used at Staples. We can redeem this reward for any purchase in the store and online.
